No more than \$45,600 may be contributed to candidates, no more than \$69,900 may be contributed to PACs and party committees, and no more than \$45,600 may be contributed to party committees that are not national party committees.

² This limit is shared by the Senatorial committee and the national committee. A campaign includes both the primary and general elections.
